

FREE SHUTTLE BUSES AND PARKING FOR MUSICFEST VOLUNTEERS FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHTS

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY AS SOME OF THE LOTS PREVIOUSLY USED FOR VOLUNTEER PARKING ARE NO LONGER BEING USED.

Neither the school district administration building parking lot nor the Hamilton Elementary School lots will be used this year for volunteers.

Instead, Prior Lake High School Lot A may be accessed using 150th Street from either the west (TH 13) or east (CR27). In either case turn south on the high school driveway which aligns north and south with Virginia Avenue. Once on campus, signs will direct you to Volunteer lot A. This is the upper lot used to enter the activities center.

Shuttles from High School Lot A to and from the festival grounds begin at 2pm Friday and Saturday (July 12 and 13) and conclude at midnight.

This year each volunteer will receive a parking pass for the night they are volunteering. That pass must be shown to enter the volunteer parking lot. The lot will only be accessible to those scheduled to work that night. If you work both nights, you will receive two separate passes. Persons without a pass or with a pass for the wrong night may not use the shuttle. Contact rotarymusicvolunteers@gmail.com before the event if you have questions or need more information.

Volunteers may choose to use any other shuttle buses, but they will be dropped off and picked up at the same locations as all other festival attendees.
